## MoU ON REPRINTING A.L.I. PUBLICATIONS

The Academy for Learning Islam (A.L.I.) is a not-for-profit registered charity based in Toronto, Canada, committed to teaching and explaining the religious tenets, history and practice of Islam according to the Shī'ah Ithnā-'Asharī school of thought.

A.L.I. aims to promote holistic growth of the individual. It provides religious inspiration for the community to help them stay focused in the journey towards Allah *'azza wa-jall* and appreciate the beauty and practicality of Islam. It offers on-site and online activities, courses, seminars, webinars which cover religious and spiritual issues, nutrition and physical health, as well as emotional issues for well-being. Besides courses and retreats, A.L.I. also publishes books for children and adults.

Since its inception in 2001, A.L.I. has sent out hundreds of *Quranic Reflections* and other write-ups through email and social media. However, when it comes to print media, we have experienced limitations in making them available worldwide due to exorbitant shipping costs. In order to facilitate easy access to everyone around the world A.L.I. has designed the following **Memorandum of Understanding** (MoU) to be agreed upon between A.L.I. and organizations or individuals who may be interested in reprinting its publications.

1. A.L.I. spends tremendous resources in preparing and designing courses, course materials and Islamic publications. It aims at providing these to the public gratis or at an affordable price in order to avoid any unauthorized reprinting or republishing of our material which significantly reduces our ability to produce beneficial literature.

2. A.L.I. agrees to share digital copies of its publications in good faith with an understanding that .....  
(Here after referred to as User) will abide by the terms agreed in the MoU.
3. The User will initially pay US \$50.00 (dollars fifty only) for receiving the complete book in pdf format. Additionally, the user will decide the number of copies it needs for its organization or institution. This number will be communicated to A.L.I. and a payment of USD0.99 for every copy printed will be paid to A.L.I.
4. The User will not make any changes to the Digital copy of the A.L.I.'s Publication, other than adding his/her name and address for the benefit of students, teachers and staff.
5. The User will keep the Digital copy only for educational and/or propagation purposes and for sending out to the printer, who will only receive it for printing purposes.
6. The User is allowed to share a maximum of five pages of a Publication in digital format to promote the Publication with a third party, including the parents of the students.
